Willow Basket

Willow is a gentle and sustainable choice. It is completely natural and biodegradable.

As these coffins are ethically hand-made, colours and combinations vary.

Suitable for a full-term baby or a littler person with special belongings.



Malachi – honey-coloured willow with a seagrass weave.



Miriam – a honey- coloured willow with a corn weave.



Moses – a natural willow with a band of mature willow top and bottom.



Little Willow Basket



A petite coffin for little people. This willow basket is available in one natural tone and weave style only.

Eco Casket



This gently curved casket is made with plywood from sustainably harvested forests. It has a soft wool fleece mattress. Suitable for all sized babies up to full term.

A perfect size for cradling.

This casket is only suitable for Cremation.

Woollen Casket



Made with 100% soft New Wool, this casket offers a gentle and comforting alternative for your baby. It is lined with natural cotton and includes a soft padded mattress and pure wool blanket. Suitable for all sized babies up to full term.



Infant Coffin

A traditional timber coffin available in various sizes and colours (white, pink and blue).

Includes satin drapery. Suitable for babies of all sizes.
